BIBLE READING: BIBLE TRUTH: Implications- THEOLOGICAL CONCEPT: ROCK and WASABI discussion questions: (<i>The Bible passage and questions may be assigned ahead of time for their own personal study.</i>)	Psalm 139:1-6 God knows me intimately. Nothing is hidden from God. He knows all about me and still loves me unconditionally. God is omniscient. <i>What are the psalmist's two reactions to realizing that God knows his every movement, every thought, and every motivation? Which response do you relate more to? What is the relationship between God's omniscience and trusting Him with our lives?</i>	Psalm 139: 7-12 God is everywhere. I can't hide from God. He is everpresent to lead me and be with me. I am never too far from His grasp. God is omnipresent. <i>At first glance, verse 10 seems a little out of place. How does it actually relate to the rest of this passage? Since nothing is hidden from God, can you identify any area in your life needing God's guidance or comfort? God cares, protects, and is always with you wherever you go!</i>

BIBLE READING DUE: BIBLE TRUTH: Implications- THEOLOGICAL CONCEPT: ROCK and WASABI discussion questions: (<i>The Bible passage and questions may be assigned ahead of time for their own personal study.</i>)	Psalm 139:13-18 God created me by His infinite power. I am uniquely hand-crafted by God. He is my Creator who has planned the days of my life. The vastness of His thoughts are truly overwhelming; too wonderful to behold. God is omnipotent. <i>From Genesis 1, we see how God created the heavens and the earth by speaking them into existence. How does knowing that you are also created by God make you feel? Does realizing God's omnipotence and His design for your life change the way you relate to God? If so, how?</i>	Psalm 139:19-24 The God of the universe cares about me. Knowing the greatness of God naturally evokes a response from all of His creation. God cares and will lovingly lead me if I am willing to follow. God is infinite, yet personal with us. <i>David has realized how the magnificence of God is beyond human comprehension. In contrast are those evil doers around him. Explain his reaction to those who hate God (vv. 21-22). David concludes by asking God to search him, know his heart, and to lead him. Why is it important for all believers to ask God for these things?</i>
